Cuyahoga County Competitive Supplemental Grant Program

The City of Brooklyn is eligible to apply for up to \$50,000 in Supplemental Grant Funds administered by the Cuyahoga County Executive through the Department of Development. The Supplemental Grant Program is a competitive grant that makes awards to help strengthen cities, encourage regional collaboration and improve the quality of life for county residents. Supplemental Grant applications are open to all 59 Cuyahoga County communities and 501c3 community development corporations incorporated for not less than two years prior to the application deadline set by the Department of Development.
