Manager Mrs. Maria McGinty gave the following report:

Ice Rental Meeting

Before this meeting the prime ice groups came to the meeting so we could be transparent with them. Few people want to lease the ice rink. One team wants to rent the ice for \$250.00 per hour for a minimum of 2 hours. So the meeting was about what to charge all the regular groups here. Alison asked about the other team's rates. The average ice rental is \$210.00 per hour. Maria said the meeting went well. Kevin asked what other rinks charge. Winter Hurst, Barons, Strongsville are \$235.00 per hour. Some ice rinks are subsidized, or have levies. The City of Brooklyn subsidizes the whole thing. Alison liked that we were working with the school and felt it should be reciprocal. Alison was concerned about which team would get knocked out with the higher rates. Maria said it was more dependent on the ice schedule for the teams.

Summer Events

The Mayor wants a band or a movie at the Park for the summer. There is no budget yet. Maria called around and got prices between \$500.00 thru \$1,200.00. Different genres. The different groups would be 80's, Swing, Blues for the months of June, July, or August. They would be for 2 hours. Wednesday or Thursday from 7-9:00 p.m. We could also get food trucks. Kevin didn't think a weeknight would be good. The Brooklyn Jazz Band is a possibility and the show choir. Ryan asked about the fields being used. Memorial I is used but not Memorial II. One of the field might be re-done. One field might be removed. There is the Hurricane Alley plan. BRC programs need 2 softball fields. Memorial I back to softball field.


