

How to Vote in March 17/April 28, 2020 Presidential Primary Election

The Presidential Primary Election of March 17, 2020 is extended to April 28, 2020 and is now Vote-by-Mail only, due to efforts to prevent the spread of the CoronaVirus (COVID-19).

There are four (4) methods to obtain a Vote-by-Mail ballot application:

Website: Request a Vote-by-Mail ballot application by visiting our website at www.443vote.us

1. On the Home Page click on "Vote-By-Mail ballot application" then press "Click Here"
2. Enter your Last Name
3. Enter your Date of Birth
4. Click on "Search"
5. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and click on "Print Form"
6. From the dropdown menu select, the March 17th Primary and select English or Spanish
7. Click on "Print" then complete the ballot application and mail it to the Board of Elections

If you don't have a printer: Visit the Board's website at www.443vote.us

1. On the Home Page click on "Vote-By-Mail ballot application" then press "Click Here"
2. Enter your Last Name
3. Enter your Date of Birth
4. Click on "Search"
5. Click on "Mail Form"
6. From the dropdown menu select, the March 17th Primary and click on "Submit"
7. The application will be sent the next day (Note the postal service may take an additional 3-5 days for delivery.)
8. When it arrives complete the Vote-by-Mail ballot application, mail it back to the Board of Elections and then the Board will mail you a ballot.

1. To have a Vote-by-Mail ballot application mailed to you PRESS 3
2. You will be asked to enter your Zip Code
3. Enter your House Number followed by #
4. Enter your Date of Birth

Visit the Board of Election's Administration Building: located at 2925 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44115 weekdays from 8:30am to 4:30pm

1. Enter through the rear entrance
2. Vote-by-Mail ballot applications are located on a table as you enter the building
3. Complete a Vote-by-Mail ballot application
4. Deposit the Vote-by-Mail ballot application into the Ballot Drop Box next to the table
