

Brooklyn Senior Bus During COVID-19 – Keeping you safe

The Brooklyn Senior Bus will take seniors shopping once a week for essential groceries and or prescriptions. We will also be available to take seniors to essential doctor appointments on the appropriate medical days. Due to social distancing we can only take 3 to 4 passengers at a time. When we are full we will have to cut off the scheduling at that point. We thank you for your cooperation.

- Appointments need to be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling us at (216) 635-4222.
- The same schedule will apply for shopping and medical appointments as in the past. Mon Tues and Thur are for Medical. Wed. and Thur. shopping at Marcs or Giant Eagle. Friday for Wal-Mart.
- If you are feeling sick or running a fever you must cancel your bus ride. There will be a maximum of 3 to 4 riders permitted on the bus at one time. Seats will be marked as to where you are permitted to sit. All riders are to maintain the six feet social distance from the driver and other passengers. We ask that as you enter the bus and exit that you try your best to comply with the six feet distancing.
- All riders are asked to wash their hands before they come on the bus and again before they enter the bus to go home by using hand sanitizer.
- All riders will be required to wear a mask at all times when on the bus.
- We will thoroughly disinfect the bus at the start of the day and again after each trip.
- Shoppers are allowed a maximum of 3 to 4 regular sized grocery bags. Driver is not allowed to carry bags into residences.
- Our main objective is to keep you safe and to keep our driver safe during these unprecedented times. Thank you for your compliance.
