



## **Mobile Food Units Checklist**

## All Mobile Food Units

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### Paperwork

Permit granted and displayed via City of Brooklyn within 1 year

Current BMV registration

Current County or State Board of Health Mobile Food Truck License Displayed


### Carbon Monoxide Detection

Is there a carbon monoxide detector in the unit?(except where no CO is produced)

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### No Smoking Signs

Are no smoking signs posted inside the unit?

If compressed gas is stored or kept are "no smoking within 10 ft" signs visible to public outside of the unit

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### Portable Fire Extinguishers

Is there minimum one 5lb ABC extinguisher in the unit?

Is the extinguisher readily accessible by the operator?

Are extinguisher(s) maintained with current valid tag within 1 yr via a licensed fire extinguisher company? Follow OFC 906


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### Generators

To be 3-5ft away from propane tanks if not permanently mounted in approved location

Are generators off and cooled prior to refueling?

Units are not to be powered via extension cords from another structure!


### Separation Distances

Is the unit clear of other mobile units of at least 3ft?

Is the unit at least 10ft away from any exits or entrances to any building or structure?

Is the unit 10ft away from any combustibles? (excluding other mobile food units)


### Obstruction Fire Protection Equipment or Vehicles

Are fire lanes blocked by the unit?

Are fire hydrants blocked the unit?

Is any other fire protection equipment blocked by unit? Ex: FDC, PIV


## Mobile Food Units with Commercial Cooking Equipment

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### Portable Fire Extinguishers

Does unit use cooking equipment involving animal or vegetable oils/fats?

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If yes to above does unit have minimum 1 class K extinguisher?

(5lb ABC extinguisher is still required in unit)

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Is extinguisher maintained with current valid tag within 1 yr via a licensed fire extinguisher company? Follow OFC 906

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If applicable does hood system have current service tag within 1 yr?

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### Means of Egress

Are there 2 means of egress in the unit?

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Are the means of egress remotely located from each other?

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## Mobile Food Units with LP-Gas

### Emergency Shut Off Controls

Does the unit have marked exterior emergency shut off controls?

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Are the controls readily accessible and unobstructed?

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Is there permanent signage mounted on exterior of unit at the shut off controls that is clearly visible and unobscured stating: "EMERGENCY GAS SHUT OFF VALVE"?

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Do controls have a quarter turn valve?

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### Tank Location and Installation

#### All Units

Max of two 100lb tanks to be on unit at a time

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Are LP-Gas containers secured with non-combustible straps?

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Do LP-Gas containers have permanent protection for all cylinder valves, appurtenances, and connections in event of overtured vehicle or any other vehicle accident, or accidental contact with stationary objects, loose objects, or falling objects such as stones, mud, or ice?

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Follow NFPA 58 in regards to piping and connections!

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#### Outside Location

If tanks are mounted to rear of vehicle there needs to be 30 inch clearance from bottom of tank to the ground! (NOT TO BE MOUNTED ON ROOF)

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If tanks removed during operations from unit they must be secured to a stationary object to prevent overturning, movement, or damage.

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#### Recessed in Vehicle or Cabinet

Is tank in vapor tight compartment that is vented to and accessible from outside?

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If tank is recessed or in cabinet are vents near top and bottom of enclosure and 3ft horizontally away from any opening into vehicle?

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
