The City of Brooklyn is proud of our residents who protected our country and the residents that continue to protect our country by creating a BROOKLYN HOMETOWN MILITARY BANNER PROGRAM.

Any resident that is currently serving or has served our country in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps., Coast Guard, or National Guard is eligible for a Hometown Military Banner.

This program is for current residents and/or residents that lived in the City.

**To honor their service, the City has created the
BROOKLYN HOMETOWN MILITARY BANNER PROGRAM**

Each banner will feature a picture of a hometown hero, their name, branch of service, and name of the sponsor. The double sided 30" x 60" banner will be displayed along Cpl. Knight Commons and Veteran's Memorial Park from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

The banner will be kept at the City of Brooklyn for safe storage until the following year when the banner may be displayed again.

The cost of the banner is a one-time fee of \$50.00. To order a banner, complete and submit an application form and include the following:

A high-resolution photo, preferably showing the individual in military uniform. Digital photos should be in JPEG or PNG file that is at least 600 DPI. All photos will be returned to the sponsor.

A check in the amount of \$50.00 per banner made payable to the City of Brooklyn, attn: Celeste Westfall.

Applications must be returned by March 31, 2023.

The City of Brooklyn is not responsible for replacing banners that are stolen, damaged, or destroyed due to age, vandalism or any acts of nature, including high winds.
